

CSAV History

Colegio de Sta. Ana de Victorias (CSAV) was founded as the legacy of the Sta. Ana patriarch, the late Romeo Vicente P. Sta. Ana, Sr. He had a dream and was always hoping to be able to put up a school in a desire to bring education closer to the people of Victorias. It was on the month of October 2010 that the materialization of the legacy was officially set. Plans were made to construct the building: inquisition and gathering of materials started, location of school was determined, documents were prepared and contacts were made. On the other hand, documents for the issuance of permit for the Bachelor of Elementary Education (BEED) were prepared. On November 2010, documents were inspected in compliance to CHED requirements.

On December 11, 2010, a groundbreaking ceremony was conducted to mark the start of its operation. Having an old building established at its base, clearing of the operation site and other renovations of the old building gradually commenced.

Construction has been fully operational since January 2011 until one unfortunate storm in March 2011 delayed the operations. The first entrance examination was given on March 14, 2011. A series of entrance examination followed on the succeeding days and months.

The first College Student Orientation was conducted last June 13, 2011 which was followed by the start of the regular classes. Throughout its maiden year, the school conducted numerous student-enrichment activities. One of the most notable was the celebration of the first Foundation Day on July 26, 2011. Special guests include CHED directors, City Officials, and prominent citizens both in and outside of the country.

With its' second year of operations, CSAV opened its doors to wider horizons. With the opening of seven (7) new courses namely Bachelor of Science in Office Administration (BSOA), Bachelor of Science in Public Administration (BSPA), Bachelor of Science in Psychology (BSPsych), Bachelor of Arts in English Language (AB English), Bachelor of Science in Criminology (BSCrim) and Bachelor of Science in Accounting Technology (BSAT), and the Computer Hardware Servicing NC II (CHS NCII) along with the opening of its Integrated School catering to pupils on Grade 1 and 2 as well as on Grades 7 and 8 not to mention the continuous improvement of its pioneer course: the Bachelor of Elementary Education with concentration on General Education, Early Childhood Education and Special Education, Colegio de Sta. Ana de Sta. Ana de Victorias indeed is poised to bring the school into greater heights.
